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Dear Waste Management Plan Applicant:

As you know, the County of San Mateo, Board of Supervisors adopted Building Regulations Section 9210 - Adoption of 2016 California Green Building Standards Code (Building Regulations) which requires qualifying construction projects in unincorporated County to divert all inert materials and a minimum of 65% of construction and demolition debris from disposal at the landfill.

The Building Regulations also allow for the levying of a fine of up to \$1,000 for failure to meet the requirements of the Building Regulations.

Unfortunately, your project – **BLD#####** – did not reach the 65% diversion requirement for *non-inert* materials. Please see below formula for more details.

Material	Tons
Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)	11.3
Mixed Construction & Demolition Waste (Note: 65% of C&D waste is assumed to have been recycled; remaining 35% is assumed to have been disposed)	12.4
Source Separated cardboard, wood, metal, sheetrock, wire, carpet, yard trimmings, etc.	10.0
Total Waste	15.6
Total Recycling	18.1
Total Tons Generated	33.7
Diversion Percentage Achieved (65% Required)	53.6%
Total Fine	\$175.53

$$\left(1 - \frac{53.6\% \text{ Diversion Achieved}}{65\% \text{ Diversion Required}} \right) \times \$1,000 = \mathbf{\$175.53}$$

Payment of the fine will be required before Department staff can sign off on the Waste Management Plan Section Two (final).
